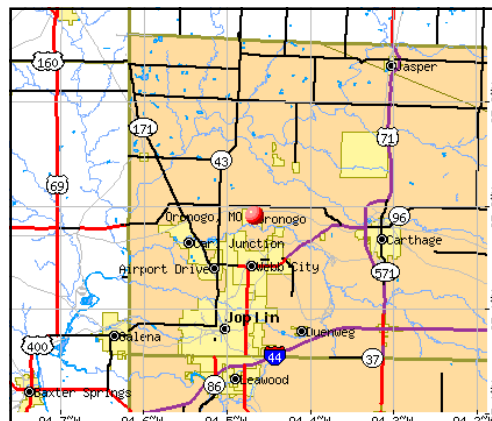
Blue Water Lake

Blue Water Lake is located about 10 miles north of Joplin in the southwestern part of Missouri, about a 7-1/2 hour drive from Kearney.

Oronogo, Missouri was a mining town back in the early 1900s. When a group of smaller mines were joined together by blasting them out and dropping the ceiling, "The Circle" was formed, said to be the largest open pit lead and zinc mine in the world.

When mining of the Circle stopped in 1950, natural springs and rainwater soon filled it. Now the clear water, unique underwater terrain, and depths reaching 230 ft. draw divers from all over the midwest.
