Bonne Terre Mine, a national historic site, is the world's largest fresh water dive resort. Water conditions remain constant with over 100 foot visibility. Sights include: mammoth architecture, calcium falls, ore carts, scaffolding, grating, staircases, pillars, slurry pipes, the famed elevator shaft, and much more.

You will do four guided dives in the mine. No advanced certification is required. National Geographic has rated this as one of the top 10 adventures in the world!
